  - Bull Meadow

Update from the committee

• Signage and entrance. One quote for work to be done has been received at £3-£4k. Other quotes to be sought.

- Pond planting to commence. Plants ordered and will be planted at the end of April. Top Cut will plant the marginal plants and the plants within the ponds will be planted by Natural Network.
- Path installation progress report. Fairways are off site for a few weeks
- Signage and entrance detail will be discussed at a future meeting.
- 2 benches are to be ordered.

#### Brum

- Picnic on the Brum update. This is to be held on 22<sup>nd</sup> July and raffle prizes are needed.
- 5.2 Opportunity for Councillors to raise matters regarding other open areas in the Parish.
  - Trees were approved for Robins Drive and Agatha Gardens.
  - Rospa visit. A swing seat needs replacing. Weed removal needed under play equipment. Teen shelter is rusting and NCPC aware of this, but the risk is very low.

  - Streetlights inspection. Ongoing.
  - Eastfield Road lighting issue Clerk noted that there was no light no 16.
  - Sling Lane lighting issue AH to pass details to Clerk not received so Clerk unable to report.
  - Light number 25 has the old one remaining. Clerk to investigate.
- 6.3 Other highways information or problems.
  - The Parish Council previously agreed to all the 6 suggestions from Barry Barnes after the meeting at the School in September 2021. Cllr Marc Baylis noted that Barry Barnes had noted that these issues had been resolved, and it was agreed that Cllr JR would send the Clerk the information to forward to MB regarding these ongoing issues.
  - Safety concern regarding the bridge on the A449 Link Road. MB noted that this was not a safety issue and the engineers had visited.
     Temporary signage notes the raised road surface, but these signs frequently are knocked over and not visible to cars.
  - Flooding on Station Road. Top Cut has visited and rodded the drains but not much improvement seen.
  - PCSO Andrea Cole has done a speed survey on Station Road and the average speed is 28MPH. The top speed was 36MPH.
  - Filter light Hurst Lane turning right to A38. MB has reported this to Barry Barnes and will report it again as an ongoing issue.

Creation of a new vehicular access to an agricultural field.

APP/H1840/W/22/3307891: Hill House Northwick Road, WR3 7RE Appeal is allowed. Cllr JR noted that this appeal resolution was an interesting point for the Parish Council planning committee to read.

## 9 Report from County and District Councillors.

## 9.1 Report from M Bayliss

- A new device for checking speeds is available a black box containing ANPR technology. The Police are also looking at true cam equipment which would mean that 1 PC and not 3PCs are needed to provide evidentiary quality speed prosecuting.
- The VAS camera has arrived, and the Parish Council are to consider the Station Road position option and a potential second site, the Lengthsman could alternate between the sites. MB said that BB will visit and identify suitable areas.
- The Shires Estate MB noted that WCC are continuing to get Taylor Wimpey to meet all the required Highways requirements for the roads and footpaths.
- Copcut junction is being revisited again to identify what can be changed to improve traffic flow.

## 9.2 Report from A Miller

- AM noted that this would be his last meeting as District Councillor but he would enjoy attending as a parishioner.
- Money for grants are available from Biffa and Severn Trent in addition to the Community Legacy Fund.

#### 10 Newsletter and online matters

- 10.1 Update on newsletter. The people who deliver the Focus are not able to continue this work and a replacement method for delivering the newsletter is needed.
