**1. To elect a Chairman.**

Cllr MF was nominated by SC and seconded by AH.

**To elect a Vice-Chairman.**

Cllr SC was nominated by AH and seconded by MF.

Both Councillors signed the acceptance of office forms.

Failure to register or declare a Disclosable Pecuniary Interest may be a criminal offence.

**3.1 Finance Committee and staffing committee.**

Appointment of Chairperson of the committee and 3 Councillors to serve on the Finance committee which will meet when the Council

deems appropriate or 4 times a year. Councillors appointed - MF, SC, MC, EJ.

- 3.2 Recreation Committee to include all public open spaces. Appointment of a Chairperson of the Recreation Committee and 2-3 Councillors which will meet when appropriate. Agreed as AH, MF, VN.
- 3.3 Planning Committee to take responsibility for reviewing all new applications. To also take responsibility for the updating of the neighbourhood plan. They will bring to the main council meeting only those applications where they wish to make an objection on planning grounds. Appointment of a Chairman and 2-3 Councillors. Agreed as SC, MT, BA.

- 3.5 Social media oversight including newsletter Councillor. Agreed as MF and AH with contributions from all Councillors.
- 3.6 Events Committee To appoint 3 Councillors to take responsibility for all public events on behalf of North Claines Parish Council. Agreed as MF, VN and AH.
- 3.7 To appoint Councillor as the main point of contact with Parish maintenance contractor. RW appointed.
- 3.8 To appoint Councillor for oversight of hedges and trees in the Parish. RW appointed.

**11 Public areas in North Claines Parish.**

11.1 The Brum Recreation ground

- Update on electric work. MT noted that the lights on the Brum are to be fixed on 26<sup>th</sup> May 2026.
- Vandalism of the roundabout and decision to be made for repair/replacement. This was reported to the Police as someone cut through bolts which made the roundabout unsafe and placed children at

- risk. It is not repairable. The Council noted that a new playground should be investigated by the Recreation Committee and a proposal presented to the Council. The area was made secure with HERAS fencing. Clerk to contact the insurance company.
  - Fun on the Brum is to be held on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2026.
  - Platform Housing has visited the houses that back onto the Brum and noted the dangerous nature of the gardens and the proximity to the public recreation area.
- 11.2 Bull Meadow
- Creative Play to visit the Tractor and assess its condition.
  - Discussion re the installation of a storage container.
  - Installation of a new memorial bench for a Parishioner was approved at £1500
  - AH is continuing the investigation to a different surface to the path.
  - The final sign for Bull Meadow is awaited and then the Council can apply for the grant monies.

- 12.7 Definitive map modification order. It was noted that there was to be a Public Inquiry, to be held by the Planning Inspectorate later this year in September. The inquiry will inform the inspector's decision regarding the Definitive Map Modification Order to add a footpath between Sling Lane and the Droitwich Road.

## **14 Planning**

### **14.1 Planning applications for consideration.**

W/26/00773/HED Land At (Os 8623 5933) Dilmore Lane Fernhill Heath. Removal of 12.5 metres of hedgerow to facilitate development of planning permission 21/02974/FUL by virtue of enabling service connections.

The Parish Council noted that it had no objection to this application as long as the applicant abides by the legal requirements re bird nesting season and the other relevant legal hedge removal requirements.

Planning applications responded to via delegated decision making

W/26/00630/FUL Planning Application Consultation W/26/00630/FUL Land Off Green Lane Adjacent To Firs Farm Ombersley Road Worcester

An objection from North Claines Parish Council was made as follows.

Applicant previously made an application under W/13/01131/OU for development on this land. This was refused by Wychavon but went to appeal. At appeal the planning inspector upheld the appeal but made significant conditions for the approval.

One condition set was that there was no reason/rationale for access to the proposed development from Perrins way. Access to the land was approved from Green lane with significant improvements to Green lane to be made by the developer. This new application reopens the request for access from Perrins way. North Claines Parish council objects to this aspect of the development as it goes against conditions set at appeal for W/13/01131/OU for access to this land.

Reports of a planning application from Church Farm for up to 800 houses have been received. Whilst this is in Worcester City, NCPC will also can comment.

14.4 Neighbourhood planning

The Council discussed and approved the quote from Pete the Planner for the review of the neighbourhood plan. The quote is for £3,300-£9,900 depending on the work to be undertaken. The Council agreed that they approve this work to bring the Neighbourhood Plan up to date and therefore to become useable. 2 public consultations would be necessary as part of this process. It was noted that due to Peter Hamiltons previous involvement with the plan, and that as specialist knowledge was vital to this project, that he would be engaged and no other bodies would be approached to quote.

**15 Report from County and District Councillors.**

15.1 Report from S James

SJ met with MF, SC and B Barnes and discussed the following highways issues around the Parish.

- Overgrown hedges in the parish were noted, and BB will visit at end of August and address the reduction of these after the bird nesting season.

- Dilmore Lane – Laurel hedge on highways boundary. BB to deal with this.
- Tapenhall Road (at the bottom) there was a house with a “ramp” on the road, which is damaging the curb, and this is an offence and BB will contact them.
- Siding out on Station Road needs doing and Top Cut is to action this.
- Potholes outside Hindlip School to be fixed.
- It was noted that the footpath gap on Dilmore is to be done by Taylor Wimpey within the next few months.
- SJ noted that he had some community funding for highways projects.

15.2 Report from N Wright/D Birch.

- DB noted that due to the SWDPR some of the ongoing housing applications would hopefully be refused.
- Flytipping schemes are ongoing.
- There is active enforcement re the car boot sale parking, please photograph and report any inconsiderate parking.
- DB and SJ noted they would donate some money for the replacement of the roundabout on the Brum.
- Noise complaints to be directed to regulatory services.
- Rural grants are available for start-ups and small businesses.
